### Analysis update

Statistical Significance - Given the adult population (18 and above) of 4274 using a confidence level of 95% and a confidence interval of 4 gives a sample size of 526 to be statistically significant. (Current 4.3)

Looked at another way, 454 replies represents 18.2% of 2,449 households in Looe.

Community Survey analysis commenced – need to 'set rules' for categorisation and get analysis in hand.
