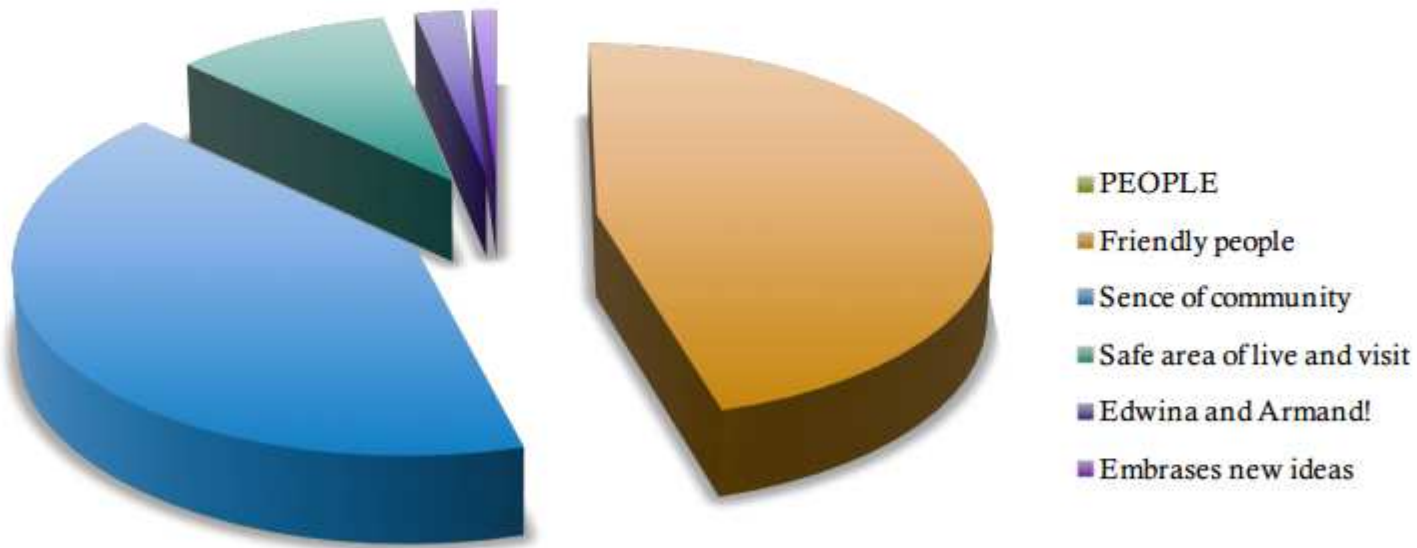
## ■ NATURAL & BUILT ENVIRONMENT

- Warm winters

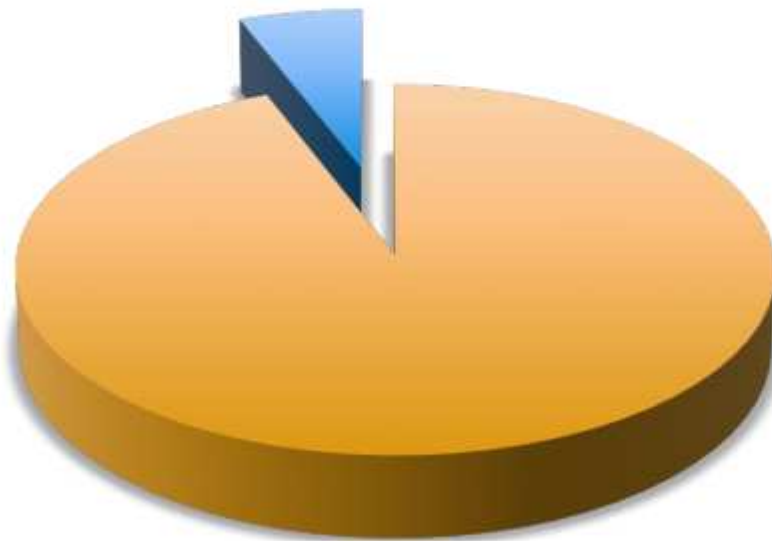

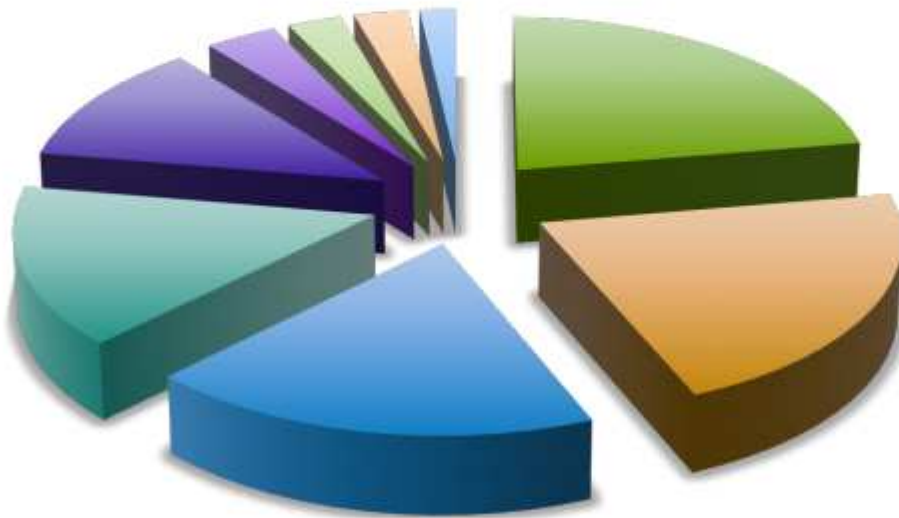

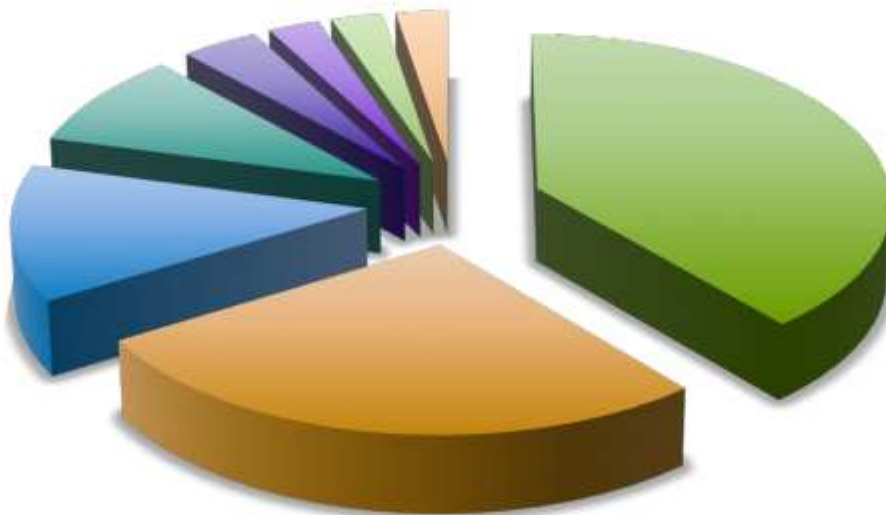


# Environment and cleanliness

- Bio degradable packaging, 'promote green'
- Do not feed seagulls
- Town centre drab, need more flowers
- Respect history of Millendreath peat bogs, solve flooding

# Parking and Transport



- Residents parking card, cheaper parking, more parking, better enforcement
- Control cars entering Fore Street and better enforcement, pedestrianise
- More frequent bus service to Plymouth, improve transport links, community transport
- Remove advertising boards from pavements and roads
- Reduce speed limit on A387 Sandplace Road and improve junction, road capacity
- Wider pavements in Fore Street
- Remove traffic calming from Barbican Road
- Smaller buses

# Shops



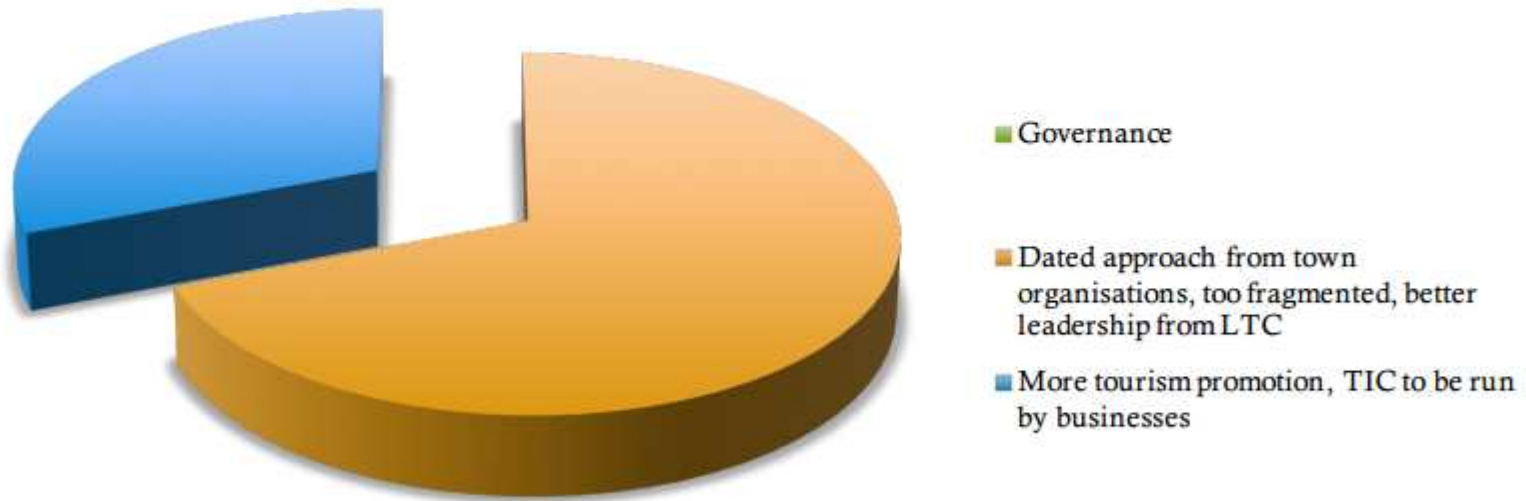
- Less gift shops with low quality imported goods, more friendly staff, mix

- Limit fast food shops

# Future development



- Less intensive development, a planned approach required, smaller scale
- More facilities for youth
- Marina and lock gates to mitigate flooding
- Be sensitive to history and local architecture, protect old buildings
- Balance protecting environment against growth
- Redevelop Boscarn more sympathetically, revamp seafront, remove car park
- Less emphasis on visitors
- Relocate fire station

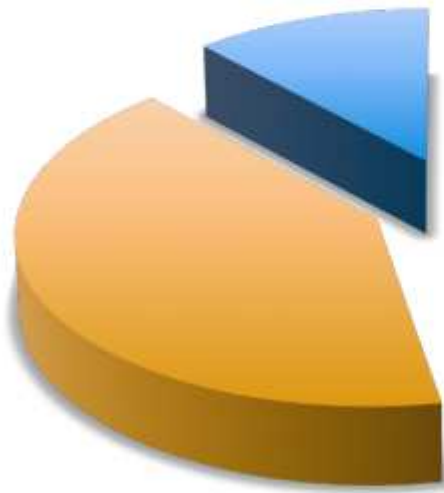
