


## **Environment and cleanliness**

- Respect history of Millendreath peat bogs, solve flooding


## Parking and Transport

Balance protecting environment against growth


Redevelop Boscarn more sympathetically, revamp seafront, remove car park

Relocate fire station




## Governance



#### Governance


- Dated approach from town organisations, too fragmented, better leadership from LTC
